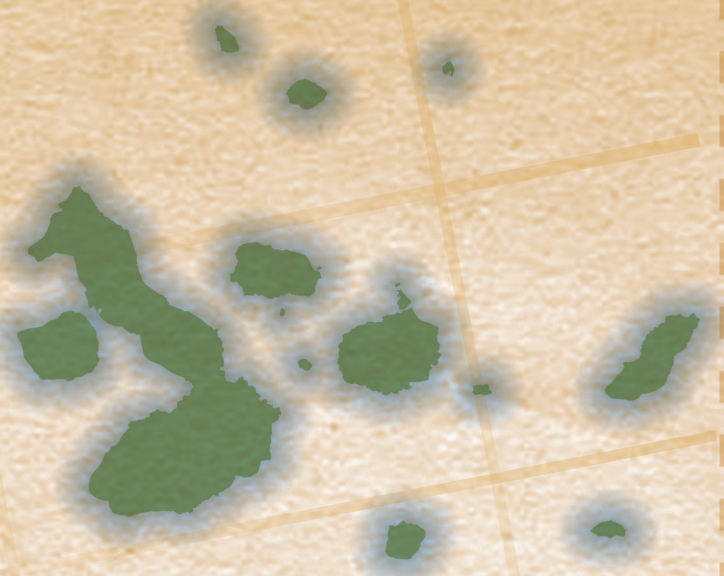


Study abroad:

Scholarships may be available for Pell Grant-eligible students.
